**Lent Notes**

**FASTING:** (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) required by all those 18-59.

This means taking only one full meal and two lesser meals. Drinking fluids is not contrary to the practice of fasting.

**ABSTINENCE:** (Ash Wednesday and All Fridays of Lent) required by those 14 and older. This means abstaining from meat. People unable to practice this bodily penance (pregnancy, illness, etc.) may choose another form of penance or charity.

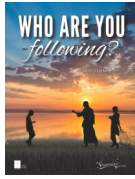
