Stewarding our Gifts: Go in peace glorifying the Lord by your life:

Faith takes the center stage for a second week in a row! In the reading from Ezekiel, we learn that the Israelites were hard of heart and literally needed to be saved from themselves. In the Gospel we hear that Jesus' own family and friends were in the same sad situation. They knew who He was, and yet they questioned Him!
