Lent Notes

FASTING: (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) required by all those 18-59. This means taking only one full meal and two lesser meals. Drinking fluids is not contrary to the practice of fasting.

ABSTINENCE: (Ash Wednesday and All Fridays of Lent) required by those 14 and older. This means abstaining from meat. People unable to practice this bodily penance (pregnancy, illness, etc.) may choose another form of penance or charity.

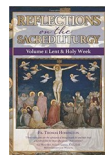

Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples

Today's gospel speaks to the importance of discipleship and training. We are called to be "like the teacher," which means living a life of mercy, generosity, and compassion. Jesus tells us not to worry about the splinter in our neighbor's eye, and to work on removing the wooden beam from our own eye. We cannot disciple well when we are spiritually blinded -- a blind guide is a false guide who will lead others into a pit. If we are to be authentic in our discipleship, we must regain our sight, but how? We can pray, go to Mass, study scripture, make a good confession, and recall our baptismal promises. Jesus the teacher wants us to be star pupils! He wants us to help one another! But first, he wants us to recognize our own struggles before we condemn others for theirs.
